Please be advised that the Stormwater Management New Products and Materials Committee for Montgomery County **recommends** the **re-approval** above-mentioned product for use in Montgomery County.

The approval is based on the following conditions.

 Manufacturer must reapply for approval to continue use of this product prior to the end of the five year period; or, the product will no longer be acceptable for use.
- 2. Driveable Grass is approved and must comply with the standards and specifications for reinforced turf as outlined in the revised "2000 Maryland Stormwater Management Design Manual".
